INVITATION TO PRE-OUALIFY

CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW TERMINAL BUILDING AND ASSOCIATED WORKS AT THE ANR ROBINSON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago (GORTT) is desirous of promoting the development of Tobago by providing the island with an international airport with sufficient capacity to allow tourism development. The project will include:

- Main Works: the development of a new terminal building and associated airside and landside infrastructure at ANR Robinson International Airport.
- Upgrade Works: the upgrade of the domestic passenger area at the existing terminal building to maintain the operation of the existing terminal building while the construction of the new terminal is progressing, and to improve the current service level of the existing terminal building for ongoing and future operations.
- **Oversight and Supervision Services**: oversight and supervision of the Main Works and Upgrade Works.

The cost of the project is being financed by GORTT.

 - Package 1 the new terminal building (domestic and international passenger operation);
 - Package 2 associated airside infrastructure, inclusive of apron, taxiway, aircraft parking and perimeter fence;
 - Package 3 associated landside infrastructure, inclusive of car park and accesses; 0
 - Package 4 outfitting of the new terminal building, including procurement, purchase and installation of terminal building equipment. 0

Packages 2 and 3 must be subcontracted to local contractors.

for any future operations.
