PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago through the Ministry of Works and Transport (MOWT) is desirous of constructing a guide jetty at the Port of Scarborough, Tobago. The National Infrastructure Development Company Limited (NIDCO) was appointed by the MOWT to act as the Employer. CEP Limited was engaged by NIDCO to provide all the necessary engineering design services for the development of the conceptual designs for the Guide Jetty at the Port of Scarborough, Tobago.
